## Obligations for Online Marketplaces and Fulfilment Service Providers



### Online Marketplaces:

Operators of electronic marketplaces such as websites or other internet services that enable third parties to offer or provide electrical equipment and/or batteries in Austria.



### Fulfilment Service Providers:

Natural or legal persons who offer at least two of the following services in Austria such as warehousing, packaging, addressing or shipping for electrical equipment and/or batteries, on which they do not have ownership themselves.

### What is to be considered?

Operators of electronic marketplaces and fulfilment service providers must contractually ensure with the distributors of electrical equipment and/or batteries who use their services that the producer obligations under the EAG-VO (WEEE Ordinance) and the EU-BatterienVO (EU Batteries Regulation), in particular the registration and participation in a collection and recovery system, are complied with.



If electronic marketplaces and fulfilment service providers cannot ensure that their customers comply with the producer obligations, these customers must be excluded from using the service.

**Electronic marketplaces and fulfilment service providers will be liable for this!**
